Bridge connection: Holme Road to new riverside path

Nottingham City Council and Nottinghamshire County Council have secured funding from the Department for Transport to provide a series of improvements to existing pedestrian and cycle infrastructure connecting to the new Waterside Bridge which opens next year.

Earlier in the year, part of the path connecting Holme Rd to the riverside path was improved, and now we are looking to provide an improvement to its connection to/ from Holme Road.

The existing arrangement has limited visibility for users and for drivers approaching the crossing point. In addition, the current barrier arrangement also causes issues. A scheme of improvement is shown on drawing P24010/GA/002 which aims to make the connection to the hook path from Holme Rd easier and safer to use.

A major part of the works involves the removal of hedgerow and vegetation either side of the crossing point to improve the visibility to meet current safety standards. To offset this loss, a new hedgerow will be provided on the western section along with a low fence. These works will form the first phase of the improvement works, and will take place in the upcoming weeks, with the remainder of the works to the crossing point, the barriers and surfacing to follow in 2026. The works have been discussed in detail with Rushclliffe Borough Council as land owner including their Ecology and Sustainability Officer.
